U.S. FARMERS BRING HOPE TO A DYING NATION

Dallas, TX. - March 2, 2007 - Swaziland, Africa has a problem of pandemic proportion. Officials say that HIV/AIDS has infected between 35 - 50% of the national population. If something doesn't change, statistics show that their nation will be completely destroyed by the year 2030. Thanks to a U.S. flax farmer and his wife, Swaziland could have a fighting chance.

A couple of farmers who like to go by "Rangeloff and Maw" have invented a flax hull mechanical extraction process which is providing hope for people with immune system deficiencies worldwide. Scientists and nutritionists have known for approximately 25 years that the lignan housed inside the hull of flax seed boosts and super charges immune system function, but until Rangeloff and Maw's invention, they were unable to successfully extract the lignan from the flax hull. The immune boosting property found in flax seed is called a lignan.

"The Good Lord gave me the idea for the process," Rangeloff comments, and he believes God gave it to him for a reason, to help those who suffer from immunity issues, especially the poor in 3rd world countries who can't help themselves.

The extraction process harvests the lignans from the hull and makes them available for people to ingest directly as a great tasting food supplement. A single teaspoon of flax lignans is equivalent to a person eating up to 2 gallons of flax seed.

The Rangeloff's have partnered with Aids Research and Assistance Institute, a non-profit organization which educates and assists in research to find natural and cost-effective ways to help third world indigent rural people who are afflicted by the HIV virus. The Rangeloff's have personally donated approximately \$600,000 of flax hull lignans to Swaziland and South African orphans with AIDS through ARAI.

Dr. Daniel Daves, International Director of ARAI said, "We believe that flax hull lignans are 'The Answer' for rural third world HIV sufferers who don't have access to expensive and time sensitive anti-retroviral medications. Medical care in Africa can be too expensive for those who's incomes range from \$30 - \$50 U.S. per month, and many times, the medical care facilities are hours or days away from many villages. The flax lignans are much more affordable and easy to distribute. The testing that has been done has shown very positive immune system strengthening results."

ARAI has been involved in 3 anecdotal studies using the flax hull lignans. The first two rounds of study involved 100 people in each round with various illnesses, some of which were HIV, breast cancer, prostate cancer, lymphoma, bone cancer, arthritis, hepatitis C and diabetes.

The third round of study was done in Africa on 100 people, all were HIV positive, and 75% experienced AIDS symptoms. The results are very impressive. AIDS patients lost their wasting symptoms of AIDS and have had HIV viral load levels drop significantly. Some have had levels drop to non detectible within 90 days. From round 1 and 2 of the studies, cancer patients are reporting reductions in the sizes of tumors. Diabetes Type 1 patients have had a leveling of sugars in the bloodstream, and the list goes on. Ten percent of the subjects reported no change in their conditions.
